Project Summary

The project consisted of a two-story building, with 55,000-square-feet. The Government Center was constructed on the north side of Smoketree Street, between 7th and 9th Avenues. Other improvements to the site included a parking lot, underground utilities, sidewalks, landscaping, and enclosures for a transformer, above-ground fuel tanks, a generator, and trash receptacles. The project included both the City of Hesperia and the County of San Bernardino in a joint effort to accomplish the new building. The Government Center was designed and built to withstand a major earthquake meeting the standards set by California's current building code as an essential facility.
